

Paid Secretary Urged for GPA

ALBUQUERQUE (AP) — The Albuquerque Game Protective Association last night authorized its 16-man delegation to the state convention to advocate a full-time paid secretary for the State GPA.

The step, it was said, would aid coordination between official and unofficial agencies for game and fish protection.

Other resolutions by the local group included one favoring the placing of legal-size fish in the streams instead of fingerlings, with state hatcheries to feed the fish until they reach legal size and increase license fees to take care of the cost.

Another advocated closing of parts of streams for a year at a time, on alternate years, to allow fish to propagate.
